**ORDER OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL**

**UPON** the meeting of the Executive Committee of Council on June 24, 2011 by teleconference with respect to the matter of Paul Lam, MD, of the City of Fredericton and Province of New Brunswick;

**UPON** having investigated an allegation of professional misconduct against Paul Lam, MD, forming part of a complaint to the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, dated January 17, 2011;

**WHEREAS** said allegation of professional misconduct is that Paul Lam, MD, failed to maintain the standard of practice of the profession, in contravention of Section 3 of Regulation No. 9 of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick;

**WHEREAS** the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick did suspend Paul Lam, MD's license to practice medicine on an interim basis, effective March 28, 2011, pursuant to Section 56.1 of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87;

**WHEREAS** Paul Lam, MD has agreed to waive a proceeding by way of Board of Inquiry pursuant to Section 59 of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87 and has agreed to proceed directly to the Council of the College;

**WHEREAS** Paul Lam, MD has admitted, in writing, professional misconduct and that said admission is filed with this Council;

**WHEREAS** Paul Lam, MD, has also entered into an Agreement & Undertaking with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, which Agreement & Undertaking is filed with this Council;

**WHEREAS** the said Agreement & Undertaking, admission of professional misconduct, and this Order will finally and completely resolve any and all outstanding complaints against Paul Lam, MD with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, whether formal or informal, as of this date;

**AND WHEREAS** between meetings of Council, the Executive Committee has all the powers of Council with respect to any matter that, in the Committee's opinion, requires attention, other than the power to make, amend or revoke a regulation, pursuant to s.21.1(6) of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c.37;


**THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE THEREFORE** finds Paul Lam, MD guilty of professional misconduct under Section 56 (c) of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B. 1981, c. 87 in contravention of Regulation No. 9, Section 3, of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick in that Paul Lam, MD failed to maintain the standard of practice of the profession.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

**THAT** Paul Lam, MD be reprimanded and serve a suspension effective from March 28, 2011 until, and including, June 30, 2011.

**ALL OF WHICH** has been duly resolved by the Executive Committee of Council as an Order of the Executive Committee of Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the *Medical Act*, S.N.B 1981, c. 87 and amendments thereto.
