IN THE MATTER OF DR. KHALID JAMIL HASAN

ORDER OF COUNCIL

**UPON THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL on June 12th, 1993 at the City
of Moncton, New Brunswick;**

**AND UPON consideration of the findings of the Board of Inquiry
into the matter of Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan;**

**AND UPON HEARING Eugene Mockler, Q.C., in support of Dr.
Khalid Jamil Hasan;**

**AND UPON HEARING John P. Barry, Q.C., for the College of
Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick;**

**AND UPON CONSIDERATION OF evidence called on Sentencing on
behalf of Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan;**

**IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the finding of guilt of Dr.
Khalid Jamil Hasan made by the Board of Inquiry, be and is hereby
accepted by Council, and the Council finds Dr. Hasan to be guilty
of professional misconduct by misuse of a Medical Consent Form to
gain access to the medical records of the Complainant;**

**AND IT IS ORDERED THAT Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan's license to
practise medicine in the Province of New Brunswick be suspended,
effective July 1, 1993 until, and including October 31, 1993;**

**AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan be
assessed by a Psychiatrist to be determined by the Registrar of the
College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, and that the
results of such assessment be provided to the College of Physicians
and Surgeons of New Brunswick for further consideration, and
further, that Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan undergo any and all treatment
recommended by such Psychiatrist;**

**AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan
cooperate fully with such assessment and treatment as referred to
above, provide any documents or other assistance reasonably
required with respect to same, and consent to, and authorize, the
Psychiatrist to disclose and discuss the results of such assessment
and treatment to the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New
Brunswick;**

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan shall be at liberty to apply to the Council of the College for reinstatement of his license at any time during the period of his suspension;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT it be a condition of reinstatement that such an assessment is complete and that Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan provide evidence that he is undergoing and submitting to such treatment as may be recommended;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan return the improperly obtained medical records to the complainant;


AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Dr. Khalid Jamil Hasan pay the costs of the Council in whole, and, as required by Regulation, it shall be a condition of reinstatement of the license of Dr. Hasan that such costs, as agreed upon or assessed, shall be paid;

ALL OF WHICH HAS BEEN DULY RESOLVED by Council as an Order of the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Medical Act, S.N.B. 1981, c.87.
